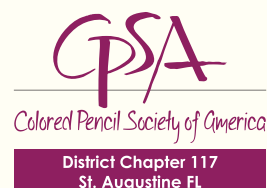

Other supplies to bring

- pencil sharpener
- smooth drawing surface (to hold 9 x 12 and smaller)
- blue or artist's tape (to secure paper to board)
- dusting brush
- 12" ruler
- scissors
- mechanical pencil, any Verithin, or HB graphite pencil
- kneaded eraser and/or sticky tack
- gum/vinyl/plastic eraser (your preference)
- watercolor brush (short-handle round #4 or similar size).
If you need to buy, find an inexpensive one with a good point.
- small plastic container (2.5" to 4" opening with lid is best)
- In addition to the pencils listed, you are welcome to bring other colors (especially on day two), but bring the 22 pencils listed at left in a separate baggie or other container.
