# **CPSA117 2024 K-9 Portrait Project**

The project started out several months ago with an invitation to the Chapter members to do K-9 portraits. But it goes further back than that. Our Membership Chair, **Linda Doup**, had attended a Flagler County Sheriff's Citizens Academy, a program to educate local residents about the activities of the sheriff's department, including a ride-along and a K-9 demonstration.

Linda realized that there was an opportunity to recognize and honor the services of both the officers (handlers) and their canine partners by calling on the artistic talents of our Chapter.


The artists drew a portrait from a headshot of the K-9, 8x10, and the Chapter provided the mats in the Sheriff's official green color. These portraits were a gift to the department; Sheriff Staley had the option to give them as gifts to the handlers, or sell or reproduce them as a fundraiser.

The presentation event on February 7, 2024 was held at the newly built FCSO headquarters. Sheriff Staley had the eager participation of the officers/ handlers. During the event, each K-9 was brought in for a photo-op. It was such an uplifting and happy time. The k-9's were so impressive and a bit of fun, too.

The Chapter also provided a letter of recognition to the Sheriff as well as dog toys for each of the K-9's. It was wonderful to meet the officers and their faithful K-9's and express our gratitude for the work they do to keep this community safe. Each K-9 has a specialty to include tracking criminals, finding missing persons, narcotic and bomb detection, and a comfort K-9 to work especially with children. The K-9's perform an important community relations function as well.

This is a project that can easily be sponsored by any CPSA chapter across the country. It is our hope that by sharing this project will inspire other CPSA chapters to do the same.




