ICDC Deeds Land To Humane Society

PALM COAST—Construction on the Flagler County Humane Society's animal shelter is expected to begin this week following the ICDC's property grant.

Hanneke Frederik, president of the Humane Society, said that preliminary work should begin within the next few days on the \$2.5 million facility.

The Humane Society formally gained its request Monday from ITT Company Development Corp. for the acre of land for the shelter.

ICDC President Alan Smolen signed the land deed for the tract off U.S. 1, north of St. Joe Road, during a brief ceremony at the company's office.

"This is a further step in the development of a mature community in which the citizens act on their own initiative to serve the common good," he said after the signing.

If all the blocks are hurried as expected, the shelter would be ready to accept strays and offer other services by June 1982.

Still left in the plan is approval of an animal control ordinance for the Palm Coast Service District, one of the three areas in the county involved in the shelter. The County Council has slated a public hearing on the proposed law Jan. 4.

The law would require licensing tagging and inoculating dogs and cats within the service district area. Bunnell and Flagler Beach, the two cities using the shelter, would have similar laws.

The three communities would share equally in the funding of an animal control officer, although adjustments may be made later if one area's needs grow more than the other's.

The animal control officer would cost about \$8,800 yearly. The amount includes \$1,000 salary for the position, \$2,000 for a vehicle and \$2,000 for transportation and vehicle maintenance.

Fees from licensing, tagging and inoculating are expected to offset the costs of the shelter. The county's law for the service district—an area of Palm Coast
